Games:

Centerpiece game:

Pass a saltshaker among the guests at the tables. Start the game with the song and when the music stops, whoever is holding the saltshaker at each table wins a centerpiece.

Wedding countdown game:

Invite several married couples among the guests on stage and ask the newlyweds to accompany them. From here, ask all couples that have been married for less than a year to leave the stage. Proceed to eliminate couples by moving upward in years (5, 10, 15, 20 years). When you get down to a handful of couples, continue upward one year at a time until you have one couple left. The winning couple will then get to share their secret for success with the guests and the newlyweds - and they win a centerpiece.
